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1. About the project

Young Citizen Of India Charitable Trust, (YCICT) Mehsana, undertook the project "**Youth as Catalysts of Social Change**" to empower the youth to promote gender equality in their own family and society. It is also envisaged that it could also complement the earlier efforts on Valuing the Girl Child and improving the status of girls and women in the community specifically in Mehsana, Visnagar Unjha Blocks of Mehsana District of Gujarat.

2. Vision of the Project

We envisage a gender just society where every woman enjoys their rights as daughter, wife, mother and sister.

3. Goal of the project

To improve the girl Child Sex Ratio (CSR) in Mehsana District of Gujarat.

4. Coverage of the project

Project was implanted in three selected blocks of the Mehsana district of Gujarat state. These blocks were Mehsana (815) Unjha (809) and Visnagar (835))

- 1) A total of 50 high schools having scout guide Unit of Mehsana Town area and Unja and Visnagar blocks were covered under the project
- 2) A total of 50 Colleges having NSS unit and running degree and diploma courses on social sciences/ social work / home science and Management were selected from Mehsana city, Visnagar, and Unjha blocks of Mehsana district
- 3) A total of 15 villages were selected for community based intervention from selected blocks having poor sex ratio. (Five villages from each selected block)

5. Objectives of the project

- ▶ To create awareness about the declining CSR in the Gujarat state including Mehsana District and about legal provisions available to curb the practice of sex selection.
- ▶ To enhance youth participation in Communication and advocacy of the PC & PNDT ACT and promote gender equality.
- ▶ To empower the PRIs to monitor the sex ratio at Birth
- ▶ To achieve the above objectives various activities were organised at community, schools and colleges level

6. Project strategies

1. Partnership and capacity building of youth networks to promote Youth to Youth and Youth to community approach.
2. Coordination with Health and Family Welfare Department for stringent Enforcement of the PCPNDT (Control and Regulation) Act.
3. Partnership with PRIs for monitoring of sex ratio at Birth
4. Documentation and Dissemination for wider dissemination.

In our society population of girl child is decreasing which is socially alarming. Gujarat and Mehsana are also a case in point. We need to work hard to change the mindset of our people. Our efforts and campaign against abortion has given good results and CSR has increased by 44 points. Still, much remains to be done and we should work tirelessly towards its end.

In Haryana, eligible bachelors have formed groups and demanded girls for marriage from political parties threatening that we will not vote for any one, till you give us girls for marriage. This has recently been in the news.

Our society has paternalistic tendencies. Earlier Dayanand Saraswati, Raja Rammohan Ray, Swami Vivekananda and Gandhiji worked for the honour of women.

Only our son will come to our rescue has proved wrong. We just honored three girls in our programme that made their mark nationally and internationally. They were:

- (2) Shweta Arvindbhai Gosai
Gold medalist in swimming
- (3) Sahin Iqbalbhai
Bronze medalist in Long Jump

They made their families, state and Nation proud.

There is a wrong notion prevalent in society that there is no son to inherit. But now we have made amendments in Inheritance Law and now daughters have equal share in their parent's property.

Who will care for us in old age is a worry of aging parents. Here also, daughters have come forward where sons lagged behind and turned their faces.

If dowry is a problem in marriage market, we have enacted anti-dowry act where those who demand it can be put behind bars.

Educated girls are assets to both the families and many cases have proved it publicly.

In beti bachao campaign, the boys also have their stakes. If you don't join, you will have to remain without marriage!

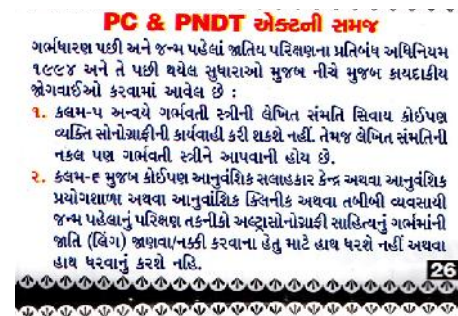

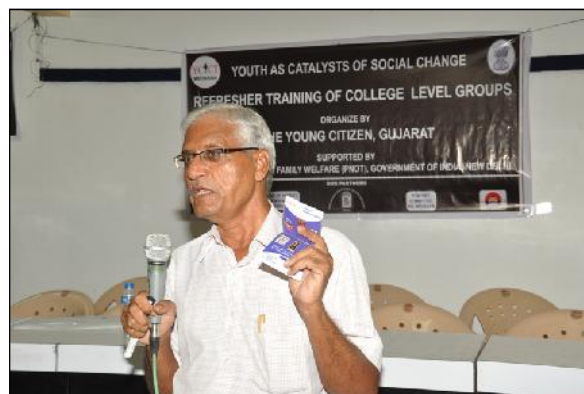
Dankesh Oza, Retd. Joint Secy, Govt. of Gujarat and motivator:

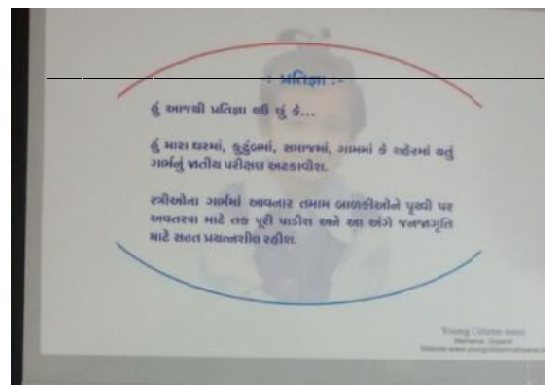

9) Learning

- ▶ Addressing the issue of declining girl child sex ratio is a mammoth task. Efforts should be made to bring multi disciplinary institutions/ groups together address the issue and develop to join hand and develop Gender Just society.
- ▶ Partnership approach was found useful to reach out to mass in limited time and resources.
- ▶ As this is a very important and national priority it is essential that budget for innovation should be made easy rich of small and grassroots organisations, so that they can contribute actively in addressing the issue.

10) Constraints faced

Total Rs. 15 lakhs were approved as a budget for two years .Out of which Young Citizen has received total- RS. 6 Lacs. The delay and paucity of budget affected the planned activities, in some point it was very frustrating to do vigorous follow up and still not receiving approved grant. In addition to this, it was also found difficult to sustain trained project staff.

11) Out come

- ▶ Around 20000 people directly oriented / trained on the issue of declining sex ratio
- ▶ More than 15000 people took the Oath during marriages village level meeting, camps to curb the evil practice of sex selection and promoting Gender Equality.
- ▶ Regular display of the data of the birth of the boys and girls in panchayat office has been initiated.
- ▶ Every month 4500 form online and send the PNDT committee

12) Sustainability

It is envisaged that sensitised youth will adopt gender sensitive behaviour in their own life and work towards gender Just society.

School and colleges being institution regular discussion/ sensitisation will continue.

Cadre of trained and sensitised youth will continue dialogue with peers and community.

Active participation of NSS/NCC/NYK will build the strong foundation and motivate youth to adopt gender sensitive behaviours .

Doctor held for sex determination test

Ahmedabad: Dr Bhagubhai Chuadhari running Sharada Maternity and Surgical nursing home in Visnagar town was caught red-handed telling sex of the foetus in a sting operation carried out by the district health team of Mehsana.

Dr Chaudhari is a habitual offender and his operations were under suspicion by the collector office as two prior cases were registered against him in 2004 and 2007 under the Pre Conception and Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques (PCPNDT) Act.

District collector Rajkumar Beniwal said crack down on the doctors suspected of violating the PCPNDT Act

was intensified as the census 2011 showed that sex ratio in Mehsana continued to be

alarmingly skewed at 845 girls per 1,000 boys. This has been mainly attributed to sex selection by the use of pre-natal diagnostic techniques such as ultrasound or sonography and subsequent female feticide.



Mehsana currently ranks 25th among the 26 states of Gujarat which is quite disturbing.

Beniwal said that Dr Choudhari was on their watch list since the past four months as there were persistent tip offs

that he was conducting sex determination and abortion of the female foetus charging couples a hefty price. A pregnant woman was readied as a decoy and a sting operation carried out in the last week of November.

"The doctor carried out sex determination of the foetus at a

cost of Rs 10,500 which is around 10 times the cost of a normal sonography test. The health team also found many such pregnant women who had come from as far as Pali in Rajasthan for sex determination. It was also found that the doctor conducted their abortion in case a female foetus was identified," Beniwal said.

On the basis of this information, senior officials inspected the premises and recovered Rs 9,500 of matching serial numbers as those spent by the decoy team. "A total of Rs 1,39,230 cash without any receipts or details of patients was seized from him. Many other irregularities were also found in the clinic not only violating the provisions of the PC&PNDT Act, but also other regulations," an official from the district collectorate said.

The entire sting operation and subsequent raid and inspection was video graphed which will now be sent to the forensic laboratory for further analysis. "An FIR was registered against Dr Chaudhari leading to his arrest. He was sent to extended police remand till Friday," said the official.



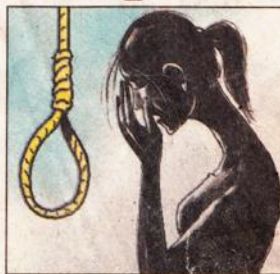
Girl who attempted suicide dies

Ahmedabad: A 17-year-old girl who had attempted suicide at her residence in Gomtipur on November 27 died at VS Hospital on Saturday evening.

Police said she had taken the extreme step when she was refused a cellphone by her brother to play games.

The victim, Gul Afza Bano Rangrez, a resident of



Jain ni Chali, Gomtipur, was a school dropout and el-

der of two siblings. Her father Ismail is a labourer at a nearby unit.

On November 27, she fought with her brother after he refused to hand over his cellphone to her for playing games.

"This enraged her so much that she went inside her room and hanged herself with a dupatta," said Gomtipur police sub-inspector J A Padhiyar.
